

Diagnostic Medical Sonography Program

Admissions Process

This program is a full time commitment for four semesters. People interested in the program must comply with the admission requirements and submit an application. Application must be received by April 1st each year.

- Interview dates will be between the end of May and early June.
- > If selected and admitted into the program, notification will be sent by the end of June.

The Admissions Sequence

- 1. Determine Eligibility
 - a. Bachelor's Degree from an Regionally Accredited Educational Institution -OR-
 - b. Two year degree in a specific patient care field, from an regionally accredited Institution and completion of general education prerequisites
- 2. Apply for Admission to Pueblo Community College
 - a. Have official transcripts sent to PCC for evaluation

NOTE: Official transcripts are requested and sent directly from one institution to another

- 3. Complete all prerequisite courses
- 4. Obtain job shadowing opportunities. Provide documentation of job shadowing with application
- 5. Submit completed application and all required documents on the checklist by April 1.

NOTE: Incomplete applications will not be processed. Applications received after the submission date will not be considered.

- 6. Qualified applications will be notified for an interview by the 3rd week in May
 - a. Interviews will be held during the second week in June
- 7. Conditional accepted applicants will be notified by the end of June.
 - a. Must complete the following to be registered for program courses
 - i. Successfully complete a background check and drug screen
 - ii. Obtain CPR card for Health Professionals (2 year)
 - iii. Obtain required immunizations on PCC health form
 - iv. Purchase malpractice insurance (at Cashier's office)
